**Updated April 6th 2022**

All protocols are subject to change based on Ontario Guidelines, restrictions and best industry practices. Students and families will be notified of these changes as they occur. All participants of CCPAC programming; caregivers, students, volunteers, employees and contract workers will uphold the following guidelines in all rehearsals, performances and events.

Proof of Vaccination	<b>All Students, Caregivers, Guardians and Audience Members are not required to show proof of vaccination to come inside the rehearsal space or the theater to view performances. Mask participation is mandatory by all.</b>
Cohorts	Group classes will have limited students to allow for adequate distancing and also allow us to move through any potential government policies that may be required with greater ease.
Screening	All individuals entering the rehearsal space (caregivers, students, volunteers, employees and contract workers) must complete a self screening questionnaire prior to entering the building. We trust that you will answer these questions honestly to keep our community as safe as possible.
Masks	Currently, all individuals entering the building will be required to wear a well-fitting mask (N95, triple-layer cloth mask, or surgical mask) for the duration of their time in the building. Masks are expected to cover the nose and mouth at all times. It is possible to sing comfortably in a mask and we can offer tips on best mask choices for that activity. If a student arrives with an insufficient mask we will give them a medical mask to use for that rehearsal. We will follow all government guidelines on best mask practices for fully vaccinated individuals and vocalists. For individuals who are not able to wear a mask please contact us directly for information.
Sanitizing	All individuals entering the building must hand sanitize upon entry and

	<p>exit. Additional hand sanitizing will be required after and before adjusting your mask as well as leaving or coming back from the washroom. All high touched surfaces will be sanitized throughout the evening and shared equipment will be sanitized before a new cohort enters.</p>
Physical Distancing	<p>We will continue to follow government guidelines regarding physical distance in all of our programs, we will do the best to keep all of our students safe.</p> <p>Due to the nature of our programming and space there will be no waiting room available for parents or guardians this year. On drop off you will be able to bring your student to the building entrance to drop them off with a CCPAC employee, they will then bring them to the rehearsal space. Throughout the duration of class parents and guardians will have to wait outside. For pickup you can wait outside of the building entrance for a CCPAC employee to bring out the students for pickup.</p>
Contact Tracing	<p>Should a positive case be confirmed that affects you or your student you will be notified as soon as possible. Additionally we ask that you contact us directly if you have a confirmed positive case and follow all public health instructions.</p>
Shut Down	<p>If for some reason classes are shut down due to Covid-19 we will be moving to online classes. We have a plan in place to ensure that classes will be done with the most expertise possible to give students a similar experience online. <i>Students will be expected to stay registered in the class if it does move to online to not disrupt the performance.</i> We are hopeful that the time spent online will be minimal this year, if any, and we are just remaining prepared if the Ontario guidelines were to change.</p>
