Throughout the camp, students will work on preparing a full musical theater show with singing, dancing, and acting.

From auditions to rehearsals, learning choreography, memorizing lines, and refining their performances, our team will guide and support campers every step of the way—while ensuring they have a ton of FUN! Position Overview:

We are seeking an enthusiastic and organized **Sr. Musical Theater Summer Camp Assistant** to lead and oversee camp programming. This role involves supervising rehearsals, assisting with performance preparation, ensuring a structured and supportive environment, and fostering a positive experience for all campers. Ideally the candidate selected learns from our current Coordinator and is training to take over this position in summer 2026 or continue as a part of our camp staff as we grow.

Key Responsibilities:

- Develop and facilitate engaging musical theater activities, including audition preparation, acting exercises, dance rehearsals, and vocal training.
- Guide students through the process of putting on a full-scale musical theater performance.
- Supervise and support campers, ensuring a safe and inclusive environment.
- Assist with set design, prop making, and costume coordination.
- Organize team-building activities and outdoor/indoor games.
- Communicate with parents/guardians about camper progress and camp details.
- Assist with the end-of-session showcase performance.

Qualifications:

- Must be 16 years of age minimum, priority will be given to applicants that have their Ontario Secondary School Diploma and/or training in the arts in a Post Secondary program
- Experience working with children and youth in an educational or performing arts setting.
- Background in musical theater, dance, or music preferred.
- Strong leadership, communication, and organizational skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively with fellow staff and provide mentorship to campers.
- Passion for youth development and performing arts education.
- CPR and First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain before camp starts).
- Must pass a vulnerable sector check.
